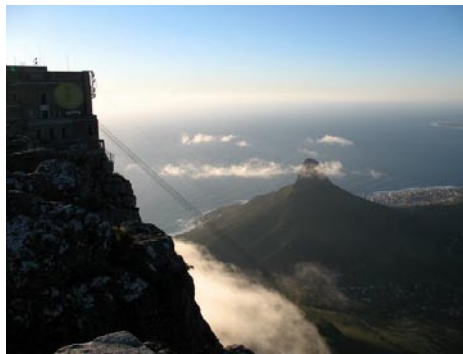

Day 1:

We will transfer you from your lodge / GH to O R Tambo International Airport in order for you to catch a morning flight to Cape Town. Your guide will meet you on arrival in CT. **Optional and weather permitting** - take the cableway up Table Mountain and then you can enjoy a city orientation tour of South Africa's beautiful mother city, this tour includes the Castle of Good Hope, Parade Ground, City Hall, Houses of Parliament, Tuinhuis and the Dutch East India Company Gardens.

Day 2:

Take a scenic drive around the Cape of Good Hope. Visit Hout Bay and the Cape Fur Seal colony on Duiker Island, Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, Cape Point and the Boulders - Penguins. Have lunch at one of the numerous restaurants in Simonstown, before returning to Cape Town. Evening at leisure.

Day 3:
